First School

Girls Uniform:

- School tartan pinafore or Kilt
- White shirt
- School Maroon Cardigan/jumper with yellow trim and logo
- Tie
- White/grey/maroon socks or tights
- Black shoes

During the summer months girls may wear a yellow checked or striped dress.

Boys Uniform:

- School Maroon jumper with yellow trim and logo
- White Shirt and School tie
- Grey trousers
- Black shoes



Middle School

Girls Uniform:

- School tartan pinafore or Kilt
- White shirt
- School Maroon Cardigan/jumper with yellow trim and logo
- Tie
- White/grey/maroon socks or tights
- Black shoes

During the summer months girls may wear a yellow checked or striped dress.

Boys Uniform:

- School Maroon jumper with yellow trim and logo
- White Shirt and School tie
- Grey trousers
- Black shoes





Upper School

Girls Uniform:

- School Blazer (Year 5 and 6)
- School tartan pinafore or skirt
- White shirt
- School Maroon Cardigan or Jumper with yellow trim and logo
- Tie
- White/grey/maroon socks or tights
- Black shoes

During the summer months, girls may wear a yellow checked or striped dress or school tartan kilt with white reverse collar shirt (no tie).

Boys Uniform:

- School Black Blazer
- School maroon jumper with yellow trim and logo
- White shirt and School tie
- Grey trousers
- Black shoes

During the summer months boys may wear shorts with a short-sleeved shirt and tie.



PE Kits

School PE Kit:

- School PE kit
- Black pumps

All uniform is available from the school office together with book bags and PE bags.

Children may wear their summer uniform after the Easter break until the end of the summer term. Children will return to school after the summer holidays in their full winter uniform.

For health and safety reasons children are not allowed to wear jewellery.

Long hair should be tied back and hair accessories need to be in school colours.

Trainers are not allowed. Children wearing inappropriate footwear will be asked to wear gym shoes. Children may bring trainers into school to change into for playtimes and lunchtimes.

It is essential that all clothing is named so that mislaid articles can be identified and returned.
